




Our Core Mission Coaching

ST PAT'S ARMAGH ZERO TO HERO IN 3 YEARS!

Just 3 years ago St Pat's Armagh signed up to The Cleveland Project's Coaching Program. St Pat's has a strong history of basketball dating back to the 70's and we were delighted when they reintegrated basketball for their current students.

Last year St Pat's won the Bronze Medal in the All-Ireland A Division! That's incredible progress in three years!



In the 2023/2024 Academic year The Cleveland Project sponsored Danny Lavelle and Ryan Berger to attend Queen's University, Belfast. This enhances the young Cleveland players' employment prospects and career development while they simultaneously participate in our program as coaches, leaders and mentors, raising the standard and prominence of basketball in Northern Ireland.

Ryan was Head Coach of the newly formed U20 Phoenix Wolves National League Squad and Danny a squad player. The team **won the All- Ireland National League Plate** in their first year.

Ryan has recently moved back to Cleveland following completion of his one year Master's Degree. Danny remains in Belfast to complete his Undergrad Degree along with our newest 2024/2025 Cleveland Project Scholar, Patrick Daugherty.

Ryan and Danny got to opportunity to meet former NBA Star Enes Kanter Freedom at the One Young World Conference held at Queen's University. They scored buckets over him... and got to ask him questions about his experience.

Basketballs

Last year we **shipped around 300 basketballs to Northern Ireland.** It's one of our goals at The Cleveland Project to put as many basketballs as possible in the hands of kids in N.I.

We aim to increase this number so that we can increase the development and opportunities of our youth by providing the fundamentals - one basketball. For kids in Northern Ireland, access to basketball courts and basketball resources are more limited than they are in the States.

When we can put a basketball in the hand of another kid we give them the power to develop their skills at any time of the day... in the backyard, on the block or on the walk to school.



THE CLEVELAND PROJECT'S 'BELFAST DOZEN'

OUR BALL SKILLS PROGRAM CREATED BY RUS BRADBURD, THE LEGENDARY BALL HANDLER, US COLLEGE COACH AND AUTHOR

Phoenix Basketball Club Sponsorship

We work in collaboration with Phoenix Basketball Club, Lisburn. Phoenix is one of the biggest Clubs in Northern Ireland and is a direct participation pathway for our kids who pick the game up in our Schools Program.

In addition to youth teams competing across Northern Ireland, Phoenix competes across Ireland in the National League and National Cup Division 1 at U18, U20 and Senior Ages. This provides a further pathway outside of local level for kids and adults.

The Women's Squad is the Phoenix Rockets, who won the National League Cup in 2023. The **U18 Boys Squad** won the National League Cup in 2024 in their first year.

Jim Martin is a notorious Phoenix and Cleveland Project Coach. He led the U18 Boys to Victory and received Basketball Ireland's award for **Irish Underage Coach of the Year.** We're honored to have such reputable coaches on The Cleveland Project Team.

The newly formed U20 Phoenix Wolves squad provided Project Scholar Danny Lavelle the opportunity to play nationally and Scholar Ryan Berger to lead them as Head Coach.

U13 All-Star Development Squads

This year saw the formation of The Cleveland Project U13 All-Star Squads.

This initiative is designed to develop the best players outside of the club and school season which wraps up in the spring-time and provide them additional expert coaching in an 'elite squad' setting with other talented selected players.

Following trials, we selected 40 players of girls and boys who worked hard in our 8 week training program with coaches Fergus Donnelly, Jim Martin, Ryan Berger, Rebecca Barker and Anna Brennan.

We held our own tournament in Lisburn against strong teams from Dublin, we were invited to the Clutch Academy Tournament in the South of Ireland and to a Charity Tournament in Spain!
